PUBLIC COMMISSIONS [COMMUNITY WORK]

- **WILD BOAR, HERB SHEAF & BELL** – Commission to carve two life-size Wild Boar with Coat of Arms to be sited on the entrance gates of Stiffkey Old Hall, Noth Norfolk, built in 1576-81. These two Wild Boar form part of a commission of four sculptures, the remaining two sculptures are of a 'Herb Sheaf' and a 'Bell', all carved in Portland Stone.
- **SOURCE OF LIFE – SAINSBURY'S** – Obelisk sculpture. Abstract water feature sculpture representing the source of life in an ecological and spiritual sense, with symbolic use of glass, stone and water for the entrance of the Life Park at Lombardy Retail Park, Hayes, Middlesex. Worked with the renowned Landscape Architect – Phillip Cave and was unveiled by Gordon McCloud - Head of Parks & Leisure, Hillingdon Borough Council.
- **BEDFORD SHEEP** – Five life-size steel sheep to act as trelliswork for willow growth with concrete solid heads, as part of a sponsored roundabout development. Phil Nicholson - Landscape Architect – Parks & Leisure, Bedford Borough Council.
- **GRIMSDYKE PROJECT** – Harrow Heritage Trust, commission for three Purbeck Stone plinths mounted with plaques for ancient earthwork sites in Harrow, Middlesex.
- **MOTHER & CHILD** – Life-size Clunch stone carving for a childcare centre in Birmingham opened by H.R.H. Princess of Wales.
- **MERLIN & HIS WIFE** – Two mounted heads in Clipsham stone for Harrow Museum & Heritage Centre, placed in Headstone Manor Park, Harrow. Unveiled by Timothy Mason – Chief Executive of the London Arts Board and Harrow Major - Gerry Harsant.
- **ADAM & EVE** – commissioned by London Borough of Hillingdon for the Southlands Art Centre's Garden in West Drayton, Middlesex. Two life and a half size 3 tonne figures in Indiana Limestone unveiled by The Rt. Hon Tim Renton MP – Minister for the Arts and Norman Leddy – Head of Parks & Leisure and Phil Nicholson – Landscape Architect, Hillingdon Borough Council.
